

MINUTES OF THE ADDITIONAL MEETING OF THE
BLOOMINGTON BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS
October 25, 2013

The meeting of the Board of Fire and Police Commission was called to order at 4:01 p.m. on October 25, 2013 at the Bloomington City Hall, Corporation Counsel Office's Conference Room.

Motion by Commissioner Schroeder-Concklin, seconded by Commissioner Messinger to recess to Executive Session regarding Personnel matters, Section 2 (c) (1). Time: 4:02 p.m.

Police:

Motion by Commissioner Messinger, seconded by Commissioner Schroeder-Concklin to remove Scott Clarkson, entry level Police Patrol Officer candidate, from further consideration based upon character issues.

Motion by Commissioner Messinger, seconded by Commissioner Schroeder-Concklin to make conditional job offers to Alejandro Vasquez and Joseph Rizzi, Experienced Officer Hiring Program candidates.

Angie Brown, HR Specialist, informed the Commission that she planned to have the background investigations and polygraph examination reports for the entry level Police Patrol Officer candidates in the near future. ISP (Illinois State Police) Academy was scheduled for January 2014. She expressed her concern regarding the comprehensive physicals which included a psychological exam and time line for same due to the holiday season. The City hoped to hire four to five (4 – 5) entry level Police Patrol Officer candidates.

Clay Wheeler, Asst. Police Chief, informed the Commission that the City lost its top candidate to the Village of Deerfield.

Ms. Brown recommended that the Commission change its November 4, 2013 regular meeting date.

Commissioner Witte informed the Commission that he was not available on November 4, 2013.

Fire: Angie Brown, HR Specialist, informed the Commission that the Board would need to meet again after November 9, 2013, (CPAT license filing deadline). She would present a listing of who had filed valid CPAT licenses. This was a requirement for entry level Firefighter candidates.

Consensus reached to reschedule the November 4, 2013 meeting to a date later in the month.
