Consideration and action on the Application of LKH II, Inc., d/b/a 1107 West Lounge, located at 1107 West Locust Street, for a Class TAPS (Tavern, All Types of Alcoholic Liquor, Package Sales for Consumption Off Premises, and Sunday Sales) liquor license, which allows the sale of alcoholic liquor by the glass for consumption on the premises, and the retail sale of packaged liquor for consumption off premises seven (7) days a week, as requested by the City Clerk Department. (*Recommended Motion:* The proposed License be approved, contingent upon compliance with all building, health and safety codes.)
- K. Consideration and action on the Application of Biaggi's Ristorante Italiano, LLC., d/b/a Biaggi's Ristorante Italiano, requesting an RAPS (Restaurant, All Types of Alcohol, Package Sales for Consumption Off Premises, and Sunday Sales) liquor license, which would allow the sale of all types of alcohol by the glass for consumption on the premises, and the retail sale of packaged liquor for consumption off premises seven (7) days a week, as requested by the City Clerk Department. (*Recommended Motion:* The proposed License be approved, contingent upon compliance with all health and safety codes.)
