**BACKGROUND:** On June 21, 2016, Bloomington Liquor Commissioner, Tari Renner, called the Special Liquor Hearing to order to hear the request of Bloomington-Normal Jaycees, located at P.O. Box 42, for a Limited Alcoholic Liquor License, Class LB, which would allow the selling and serving of beer and wine only by the glass for consumption on the premises for a fundraiser to be held on August 5, 2016 from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Miller Park Zoo, 1020 S Morris Ave.

Present were Commissioner Tari Renner, Asst. Corporation Counsel George Boyle, and Cherry Lawson, City Clerk.

Shelley Lukaszak and Lauren Lacy addressed the Commission. A fundraising event at the Miller Park Zoo is planned for August 5, 2016 from 5:00 to 8:00 pm. Food and beverages would be offered to attendees at the Zoo. Beer and wine only would be served.

Commissioner Renner recommended that an LB liquor license be created for Bloomington-Normal Jaycees for a fundraiser to be held on August 5, 2016 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Miller Park Zoo, 1020 S Morris Ave.

**RECOMMENDATION/MOTION:** That an Ordinance be Adopted Suspending Portions of Section 26(d) of Chapter 6 of the City Code to Allow Possession of Open Alcohol on Public Property in the Miller Park Zoo during the Bloomington-Normal Jaycees fundraiser on August 5, 2016.

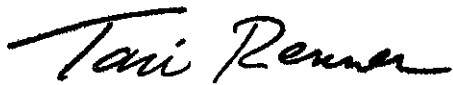

**ORDINANCE NO. 2016 -**

**AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING PORTIONS OF SECTION 26(d) OF CHAPTER 6 OF THE BLOOMINGTON CITY CODE TO ALLOW POSSESSION OF OPEN ALCOHOL ON PUBLIC PROPERTY IN THE MILLER PARK ZOO DURING THE BLOOMINGTON-NORMAL JAYCEES FUNDRAISER.**

WHEREAS, Bloomington-Normal Jaycees will hold a fundraiser in the Miller Park Zoo on August 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Bloomington-Normal Jaycees requested permission to allow sales and consumption of beer and wine during the fundraiser in the Miller Park Zoo; and

WHEREAS, to allow possession of an open container of alcohol on public property, Section 26(d) of Chapter 6 of the Bloomington City Code, which prohibits the possession of open containers of alcohol on public property, must be suspended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, ILLINOIS;

Section 1: That Section 26(d) of Chapter 6 of the Bloomington City Code, 1960, as amended, is suspended on August 5, 2016, between 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm for the Miller Park Zoo. This suspension shall be effective as to persons inside the designated area only, and only for alcohol purchased from the event vendor within the designated area. No alcohol may be taken out of the designated area.

Section 2: Except for the date, times and location set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance, Section 26(d) of Chapter 6 of the Bloomington City Code, 1960, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. Nothing in this ordinance shall be interpreted as repealing said Section 26(d).

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon approval and publication.

Section 4: This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the home rule authority granted the City of Bloomington by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution.

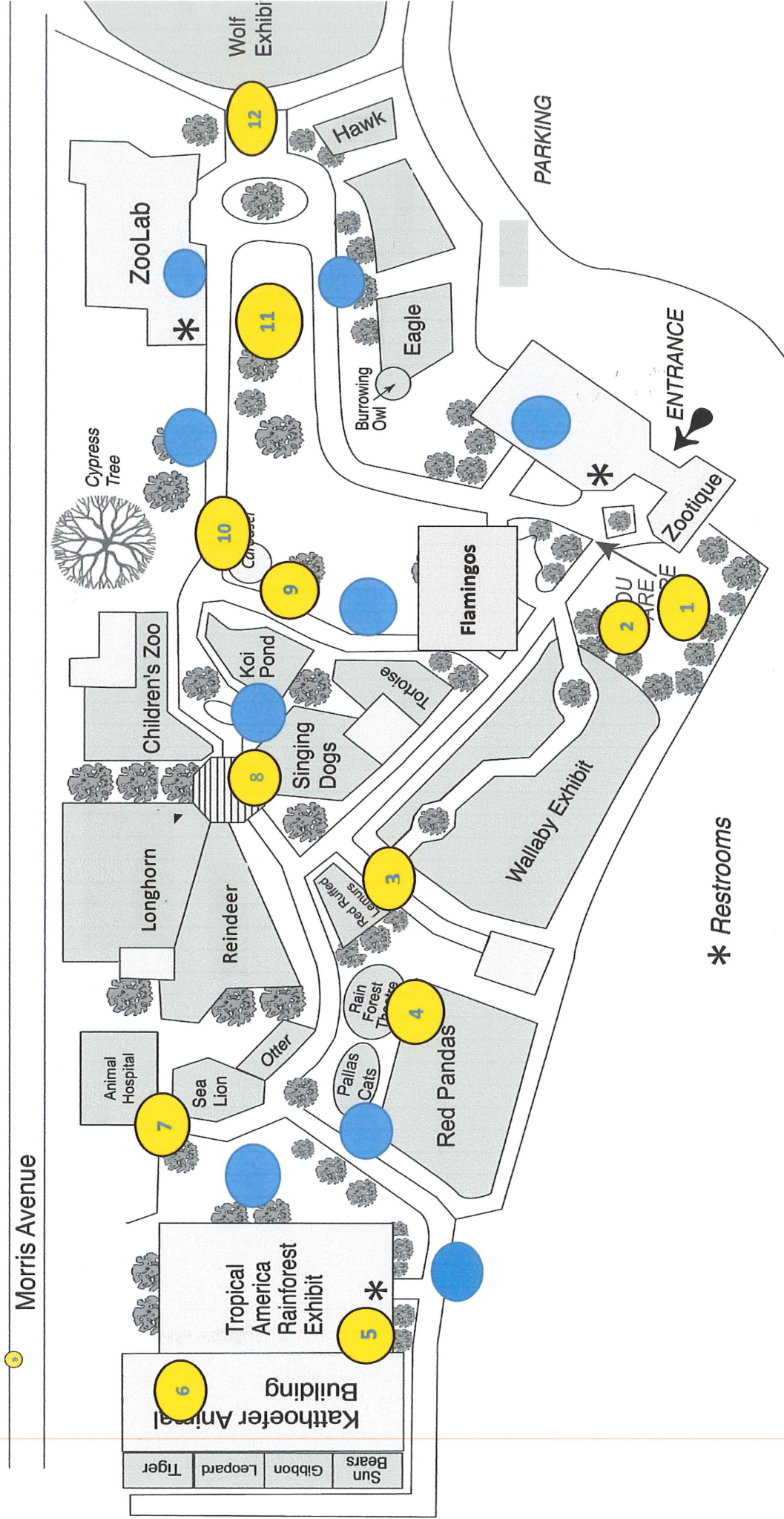
